

City of Fort Thomas Regulations for the use of Municipal Parks

- Rule 1 - Public Meetings:** No person or persons, except with the written permission of the Recreation Department shall hold or attend any public meeting, discussion, debate, picnic or gathering of any kind on or within park property; except that family parties or small groups of picnickers will not be required to obtain such written permission.
- Rule 2 - Concert:** No person or persons, except with the written consent of the Recreation Department, shall play upon or operate any musical instrument or hold any musical concert on or within park property.
- Rule 3 - Flags:** No person or persons, except with the written consent of the said Board, shall display any banner flag, target, sign or device for advertising or other purpose on or within park property.
- Rule 4 - Parking:** Parking is restricted to marked spaces on pavement parking areas only. Parking on grass areas or sidewalks is strictly forbidden.
- Rule 5 - Vehicles:** No person shall drive any vehicle over park property except the roadways provided for this purpose and on such roadways only at a reasonable speed in view of all the circumstances and in a careful manner; speed in excess of 15 miles per hour on roads within parks shall be prima facie evidence of reckless driving.
- Rule 6 - Parade:** No person or persons, except with the written consent of the board, shall engage in any parade, drill, or procession of any kind on or within park property.
- Rule 7 - Races:** No person or persons shall engage in, or in any way be party to, any races of any kind, whether between animals, bicycles, motorcycles, automobiles, or vehicles of any kind or otherwise on or within park property.
- Rule 8 - Damage:** No person or persons shall take, carry away, disturb, molest, destroy, deface, mutilate, mark or damage anything on or within park property.
- Rule 9 - Trash:** No person or persons shall drop or throw paper, lunch boxes, refuse or litter on or within any park property, but shall place the same in receptacles provided for such purposes.
- Rule 10 - Ball & Golf:** no person shall throw or bat a hard ball, or drive, putt, or play with golf ball, except at such places as set aside.
- Rule 11 - Sales:** No person shall sell or expose anything for sale within the park properties or on any sidewalk bounding such properties.
- Rule 12 - Animals:**
1. No animals shall be permitted within improved picnic or play areas.
 2. No horses shall be permitted in Parks unless and until trails for that purpose have been provided.
 3. No person shall take a dog on or within any park property unless same be held by leash, chain or cord, nor shall any person permit any animal of any kind to run at large upon or within said Parks property, nor shall any animal be tied to any tree, plant or shrub.
- Rule 13 - Firearms:** No person shall carry or discharge firearms, slings, bows or any other device by which persons, animals, or birds may be injured or frightened, and no one shall throw stones or other missiles within park property.
- Rule 14 - Fires:** No person, other than employees, shall light, make or use any fire within park properties, or close to any park fence, gate or other structure, except in fireplaces provided therefore, unless written permission obtained from said Board and the Fire Chief.
- Rule 15 - Alcohol:** No person shall take into or make use of any alcoholic beverages within park property.
- Rule 16 - Closing Time:** The park shall be closed at 10:30 P.M. daily and no one shall be in the park after that hour except upon special permit of the Board.
