

City Of Ft. Thomas Dog Park Regulations

1. Hours of operation: sunrise to sunset.
2. Any person entering the Dog Park acknowledges the risks and dangers inherent with dog parks and assumes the risk of injury to themselves and their dogs.
3. The Dog Park is for use of dogs and handlers only. No other animals are permitted.
4. County dog licenses are required. Dogs should also wear an owner identification tag.
5. Dogs must be four (4) months of age and current with all vaccinations. Dogs in heat or with illnesses are not permitted.
6. Children under the age of 13 are not permitted in the Dog Park unless accompanied by an adult. Running should be avoided because it can elicit the chase response.
7. Dog handlers must be inside the Dog Park , within view of their dogs, and have access to a leash. City leash laws must be obeyed immediately outside the Dog Park . City ordinance # 01888.
8. Aggressive dogs are not permitted and must be removed at the first sign of aggression.
9. Dog handlers are responsible for pick-up, sealing and disposal of waste in the designated containers. City ordinance #0698.
10. Small treats are permitted. Food in bowls, long lasting chews, and glass containers are not permitted.
11. Dog handlers are not permitted to eat inside the Dog Park .
12. Dog handlers must fill any holes created by their dogs.
13. The Dog Park is closed when Park personnel are conducting maintenance.
14. Violation of rules may result in a ticket and/or loss of privileges for use of the Dog Park .
