



# RECYCLING INFO



Below is the most current list of recyclable items for all of Rumpke's recycling programs. Please call 513-242-4491, extension 7164 with any questions.

Acceptable items include:	Unacceptable items:
✓ Plastic bottles #1 and #2, no lids	× Plastics #3 - #7
✓ Glass jars and bottles of any color	× Plastics #1 and #2 that are not bottles, such as Cool Whip containers, butter tubs, or food trays
✓ Aluminum, steel, and bi-metal cans	× Plastic bags
✓ Empty aerosol cans with lids and tips removed	× Motor oil jugs or other chemical containers
✓ Brown grocery bags	× Styrofoam
✓ Computer paper, and other mixed office paper	× Lids/caps
✓ Corrugated cardboard, broken down to 3' x 3'	× Window or drinking glass
✓ Envelopes, with or without windows	× Light bulbs
✓ Junk mail	× Pizza boxes
✓ Magazines	× Coat hangers or steel scrap
✓ Newspapers with inserts	× Paint cans
✓ Paperboard, such as cereal boxes	
✓ Telephone books	

## Recycling guidelines:

- Please rinse all bottles and jars, and remove the lids. There is no need to remove labels, since they disintegrate in the recycling process.
- Flatten all cans and plastic bottles to conserve space. Please break down cardboard to 3' x 3' sections, and flatten all boxes.
- Place all recyclables together in your bin. Thanks to Rumpke's single stream processing method, all recyclables are mechanically sorted at the processing facility.
- Set your recycling bin out the night before your regular trash collection day.
- Extra materials can be placed in a brown grocery bag or similar size plastic container. Please label it for recycling and set it on top of or next to your Rumpke bin. No trash cans should be used for recycling.
- Rumpke strives to accept as many items as possible. They cannot collect certain items because of contamination issues or lack of market availability.
